If you were a donkey and were reading the scriptures, what stories would you say were the most important? Maybe Balaam’s ass? Perhaps the nativity – with Mary and Joseph’s travels to Bethlehem? Definitely Palm Sunday. When we read scripture, and understand our Christian history we do so through the particular lenses of our experience, or because of the lenses of those who teach us it. Maybe that's why a donkey would find those stories the most important. Patriarchy - a system of society in which men hold the power and women are largely excluded from it – has largely been the lens through which we have understood our Christian faith over the past 2000 years.

In this short course we will take a feminist perspective on faith, scripture and doctrine to look at Christianity through a different lens.
